The Story So Far...

- Oct Mayor launches first phase
- Nov/Dec co-production work
- Jan draft policy framework published
- March policy framework agreed at Cabinet
- March second phase co-production begins
- April draft schemes published



Strategic Drivers

Community Plan

1. Strong, resilient and safe communities
2. Better health and wellbeing
3. Good jobs and employment
4. A better deal for young people – aspiration, education and skills

Strategic Plan

1. Creating opportunity by supporting aspiration and tackling poverty.
2. Creating and maintaining a vibrant and successful place.
3. Working smarter together as one team with our partners and community.



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Grants Policy Framework

Themes

- **Innovation** to encourage innovation or pilot something new, especially where there is a gap;
- **Prevention** to promote grass roots activity to reduce the need for statutory services;
- **Neighbourhood action** to promote local neighbourhood initiatives;
- **Community cohesion** to develop community resilience, promote cultural opportunities and reduce social isolation;
- **Capacity building** to enable smaller organisations to become more sustainable, where appropriate providing core funding to lever in other resources, and to support infrastructure organisations, and
- **Partnership working** making the sector more effective through closer partnership working within the sector and across sectors.

Eligibility

- No restriction on size
- Local leadership (with some caveats)
- Local area of benefit
- Include communities of interest
- Proportionate standards of governance and management – non-constituted groups supported by established organisations
- Not individuals
- Good track record



Levels of Funding

1. Up to £500 – one off
2. Over £500 up to £5,000 – up to one year with potential extension for second year
3. Over £5,000 to £50,000 – up to two years with potential extension for third year

4. Are the proposed levels of funding appropriate for this theme?



Process - Application

1. Up to £500
Single stage – simplified form

2. Over £500 up to £5,000
Single stage – standard form

3. Over £5,000 to £50,000
Two stage
 - a. Stage 1 Expression of interest
 - b. Stage 2 Full application



Process - Monitoring

1. Up to £500
end of project report
2. Over £500 up to £5,000
Six month progress report and annual/end of project report
and visit
3. Over £5,000 to £50,000
Six month progress report and project visit
