To help them on their journey we provide training courses, grants, in-work support, work placements and support to help people set up their own business. We partner with many employers to access suitable opportunities including household names like Sainsbury's, Primark and Pret a Manger but are always looking for more!



Clarion Futures Jobs and Training will expand further, with a target to support 4,000 people into work every year. This includes a commitment to place at least 250 people into apprenticeships, through positions at Clarion and with other employers, and 100 business start-ups. Clarion is also the lead delivery partner for 'Love London Working' a major employment programme supported by the Greater London Authority and the European Social Fund to support 21,000 Londoners into work and training.

The Money team helps people manage their outgoings and access free debt advice, banking services, savings and affordable loans and cut their energy bills. Every year we will aim to support 3,000 residents with free debt advice, provide access to 2,000 affordable loans and help 500 residents reduce their energy bills.

The Digital team helps people get online and make the most of the internet, including applying for jobs, shopping, accessing services and chatting online to reduce loneliness and isolation. Every year we will aim to deliver 10,000 interventions to help people get online and improve their digital skills. Clarion Futures is part of the national One Digital consortium, which recently received £4million from the Big Lottery Fund to help 40,000 people improve their digital skills.

Clarion Futures Communities delivers social action projects to improve local estates and neighbourhoods.

The team supports 75 community centres across the country run by local charities and volunteers delivering grass roots projects and services supporting their local community.

We also provide grant funding of £250,000 every year to support hundreds of local projects ranging from youth groups to IT training courses, and community allotments to new play areas. Every year we will

aim to improve at least 25,000 square metres of community land and buildings.

The Communities team also delivers programmes to support our young people make the successful transition to adulthood. This includes our national and community ambassador projects, which help young residents play an active role in their communities through volunteering, citizenship and sports projects. Through our youth programmes we are aiming to make a positive difference to the lives of 15,000 young people every year.
